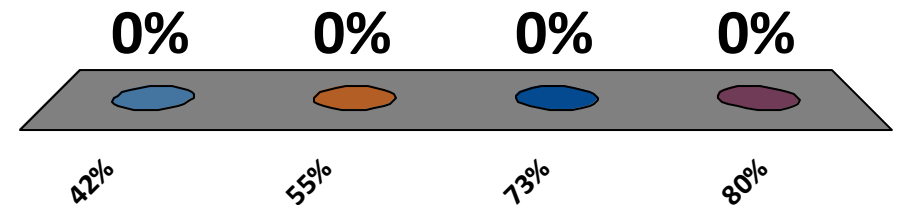

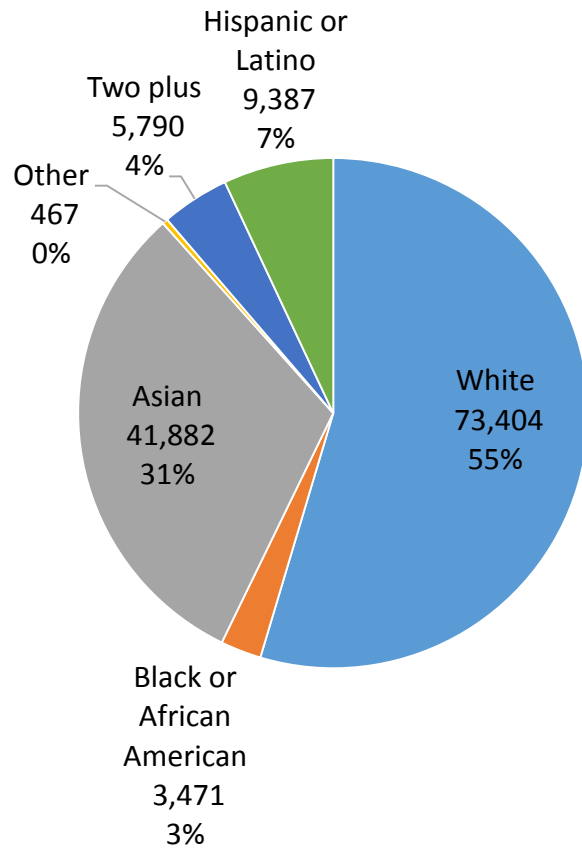


In 1990, Whites/Caucasians made up 85% of the population.

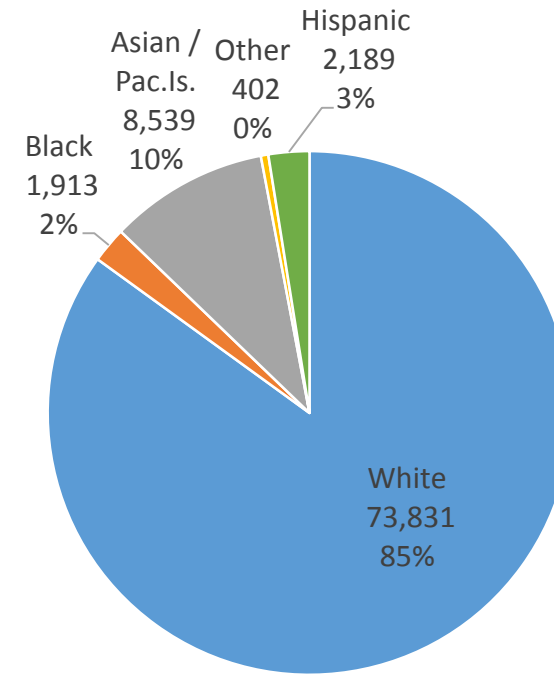


Bellevue's Race and Ethnicity Distribution, 2013

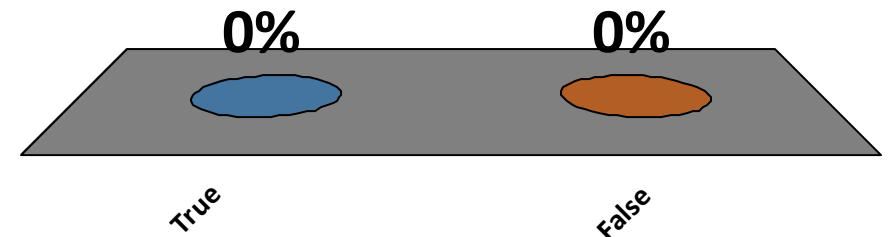
Bellevue's Race and Ethnicity Distribution, 1990

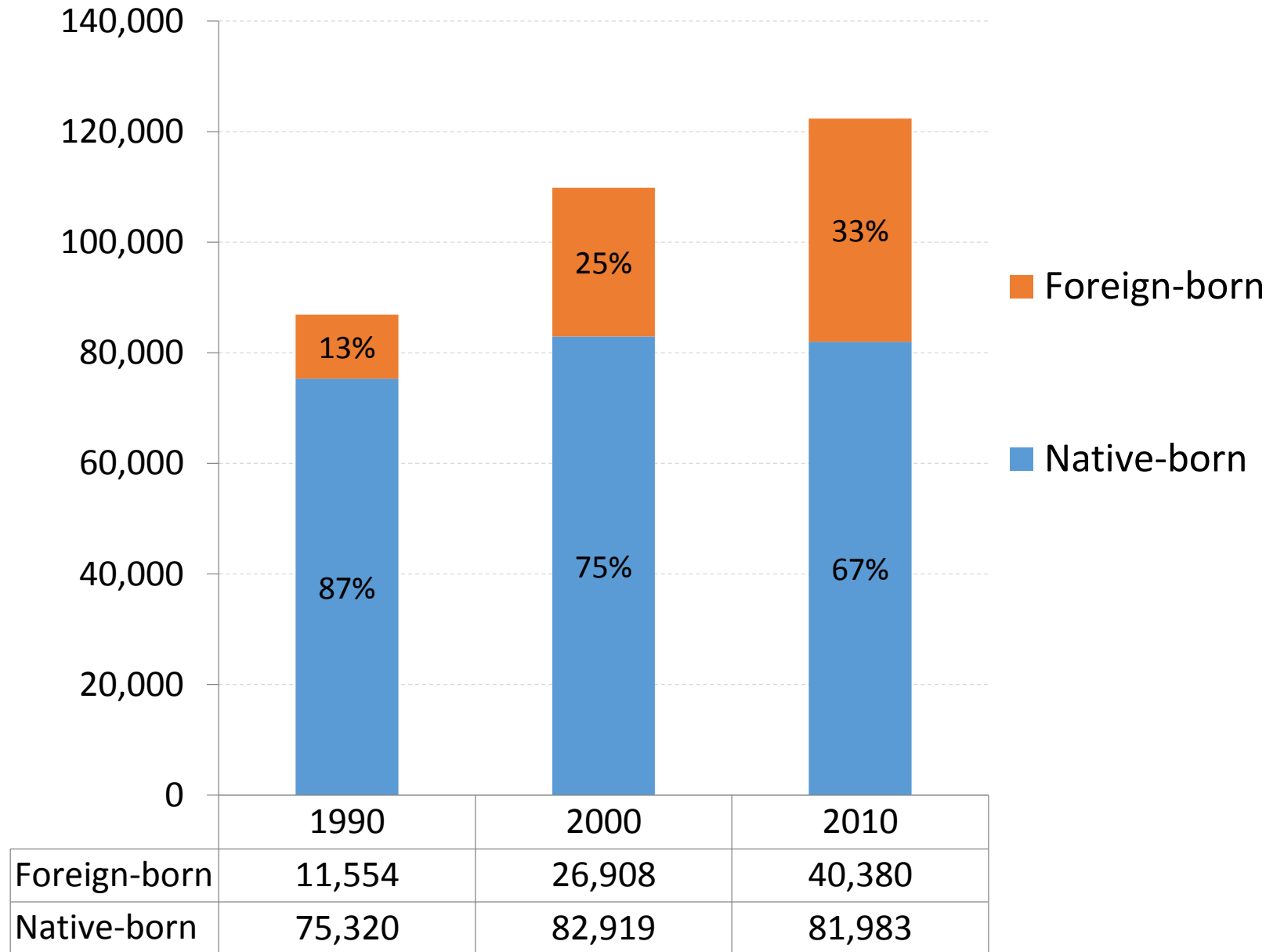
The foreign born population comprised 85% of Bellevue's growth from 2000 to 2010.

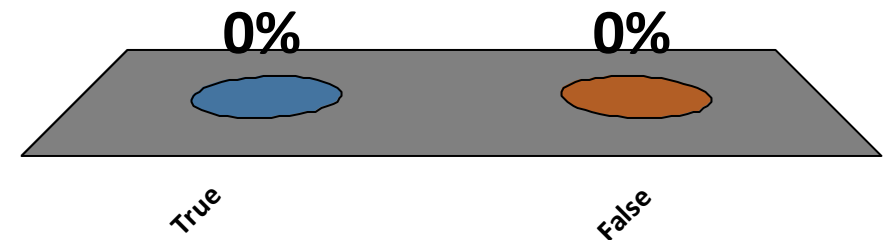
The foreign born population comprised 66 percent of Bellevue's growth from 1990 to 2000 and 107 percent between 2000 and 2010.

The minority-majority switch has already occurred in Bellevue residents under the age of 18.

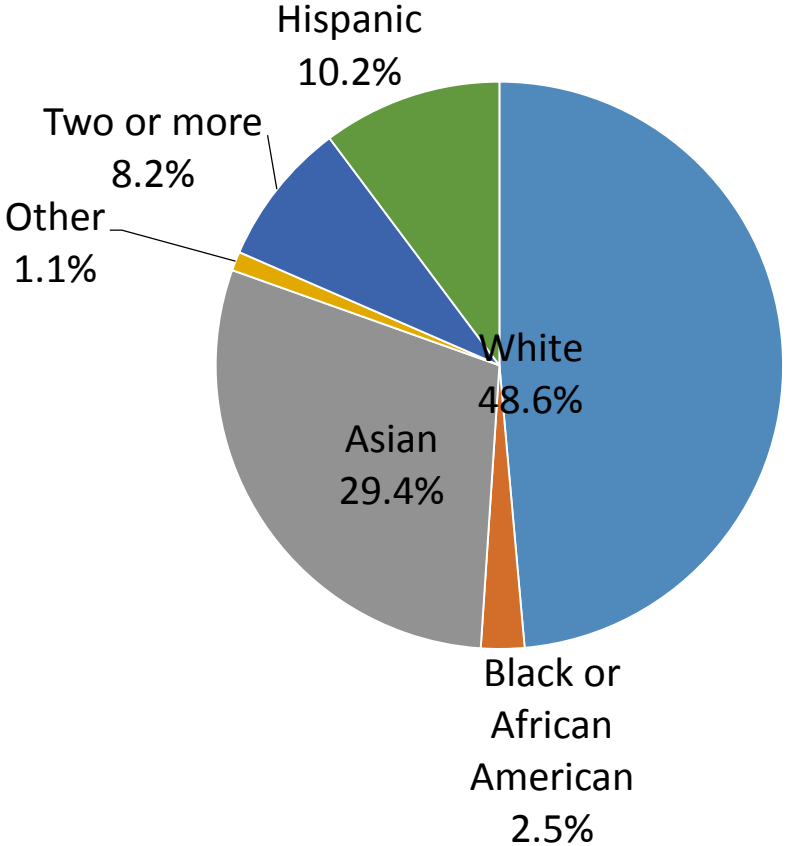

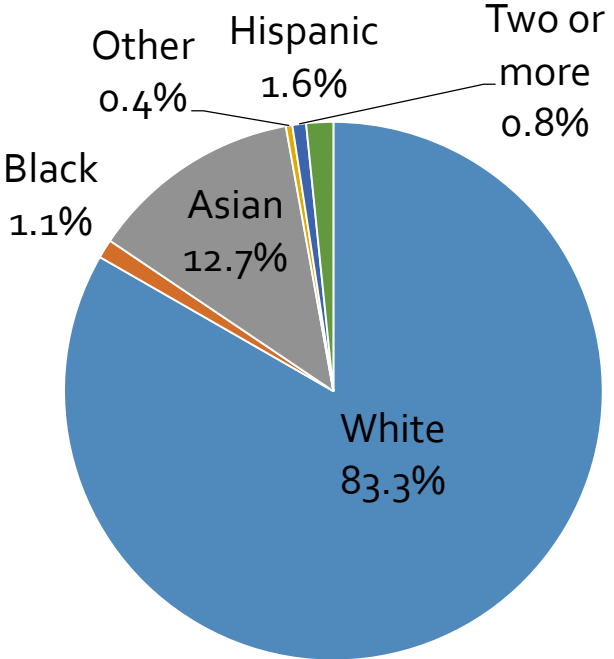

Under 18 years

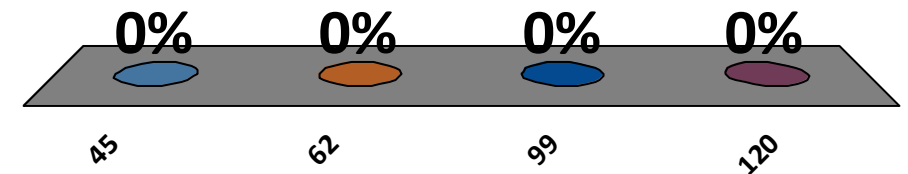


Race / ethnicity of Bellevue's Population

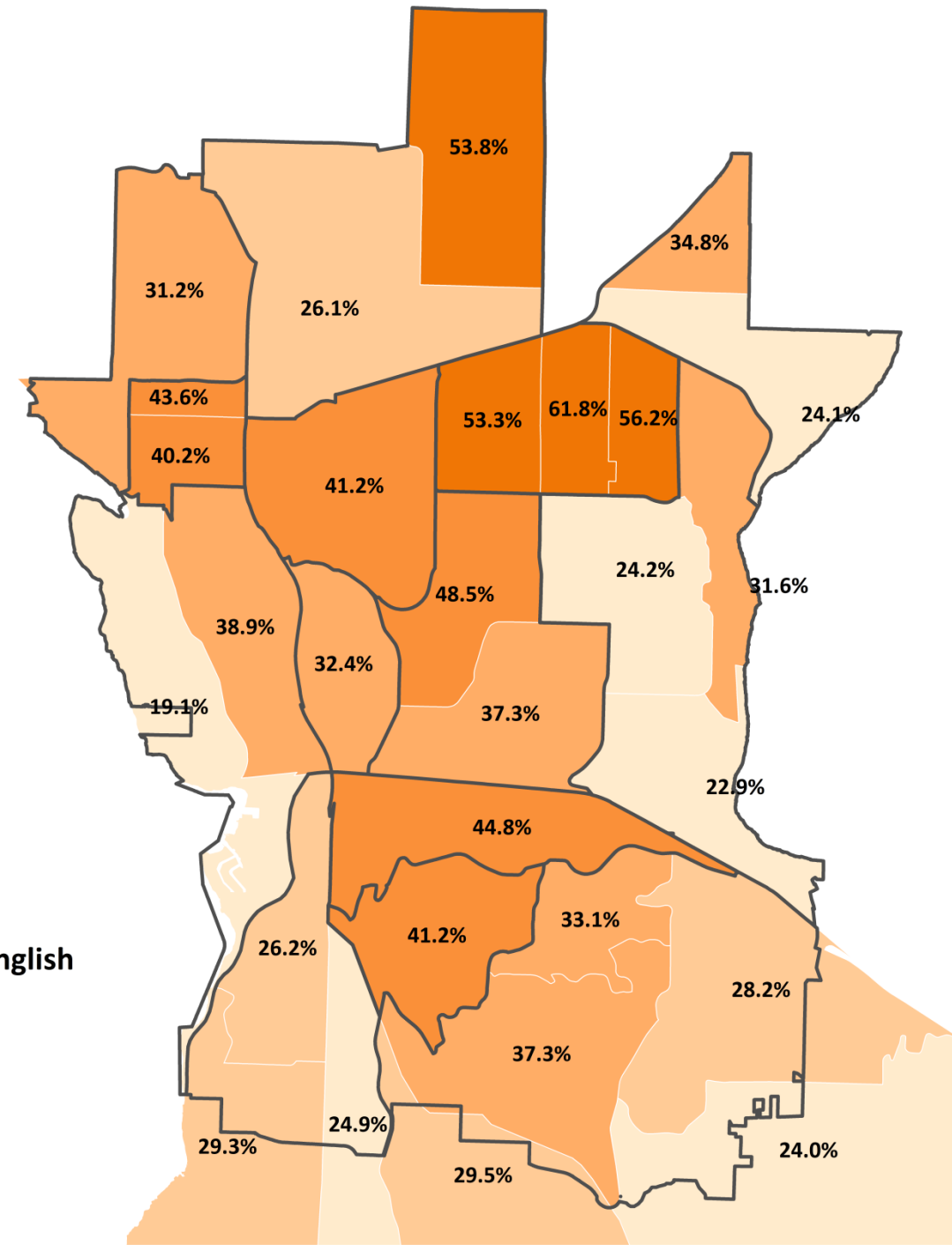

*Over **87** different first languages were spoken by children in Bellevue School District.*

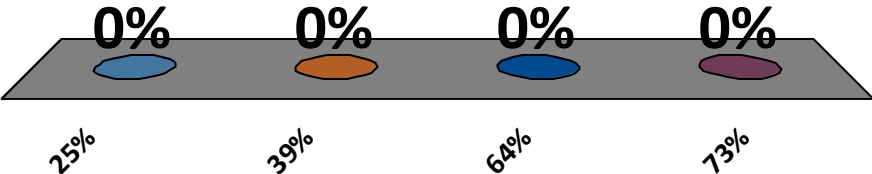
